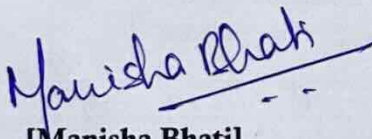

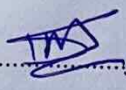

- ❖ **Responsibility & Review:**

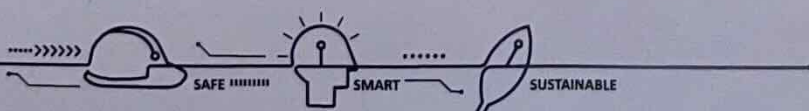
