

## ■ Hindustan Zinc Inks Pact with Serentica



**MUMBAI** Hindustan Zinc has signed a power delivery agreement (PDA) with Serentica Renewables to augment its renewable energy supply, and will now be getting 530 MW of energy from the company. The previous agreement between the two was for the supply of 450 MW of energy. The increased capacity will total to 70% of Hindustan Zinc's overall power requirements, the company said in a statement. It will be spread across high-resource locations across the country, and is set to be fully operational by 2027. "By securing 70% of our power from renewables we are targeting nearly 70% reduction in carbon emissions setting sights on our goal of achieving net zero by 2050 or sooner," Arun Misra, chief executive officer of Hindustan Zinc, said. —Our Bureau
