Hindustan Zinc Ltd (HINDZINC) recently honoured with two awards at the CSR Impact Awards 2024 for its outstanding social contributions.

The company received the Water and Sanitary Health (WASH) award for its innovative efforts, including Udaipur's first Sewage Treatment Plant (STP), RO Hubs, and RO ATMs. Thereby, providing clean water and sanitation to 50 villages.

The STP, a public-private partnership, purifies 60 million litres of sewage per day, improving water quality and supporting sustainable agriculture.

Hindustan Zinc also won the Promotion of Sports Category award for its Zinc Football Academy, which nurtures grassroots football talent.

The academy's success includes six players being selected for the national team and numerous others for state and district teams. The academy fosters youth development and builds a football culture in the region.
