The company claims to be the first company in India to have women underground mine managers. The company has also set up the first women underground mine rescue teams in the country. Priya Agarwal Hebbar, Chairperson of the company, said, "Our vision is ambitious as well as clear - to accelerate this momentum and achieve 30 per cent gender diversity in the next five years. The increasing number of women pursuing careers in mining and metallurgy is a testimony to this change."
