Hindustan Zinc boosts Operational Efficiency with Al-Enabled Monitoring



In a step towards operational excellence, Hindustan Zinc, in collaboration with V-Spark Deeptech Ventures Private Limited, has partnered with Ripik.AI to deploy an AI-driven hotspot monitoring system. The solution tracks switchyards and rectifiers in real time, detecting electrical fluctuations and sending automated alerts via WhatsApp and tiered emails. With both on-premises and cloud access, operation teams can respond quickly and effectively. This has eliminated unplanned outages and reduced production losses by nearly 20%. Through Vedanta Spark, Hindustan Zinc has harnessed technologies such as Artificial Intelligence/Machine Learning, Computer Vision, Drone Solutions, the Internet of Things (IoT), and Augmented/Virtual Reality (AR/VR) to tap high-impact opportunities.

Reaffirming Safety with Advanced Slope Stability Radars at Rampura Agucha

We recently successfully installed two advanced Slope Stability Radar (SSR) units in our Open Pit Mine at Rampura Agucha Mine, enhancing our slope monitoring framework and reinforcing our commitment to operational safety. These Slope Stability Radar (SSR) units provide 24x7 high-precision monitoring with a 270°×110° scanning range and coverage up to 3.5 km, detecting even minor ground movements in all weather conditions and offering early warnings proactive slope safety management.


