Hindustan Zinc became the first Indian company to join the prestigious International Council on Mining & Metals (ICMM) in 2025. The company also launched EcoZen, Asia's first low carbon 'green' zinc and is certified 3.32 times Water-Positive company and is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2050 or sooner. Maintaining a strong focus on exploration

Exploration

Securing Tomorrow with World-class Exploration Today

Exploration is a pivotal element in Hindustan Zinc Limited's (HZL) growth strategy, centered on replenishing every ton of mined metal for a sustainable future. We report Mineral Resources and Ore Reserves (R&R) under the internationally recognized JORC code, maintaining a strong focus on exploration through technology, innovation, and collaborations with service providers and consultants.

To advance this journey, we incorporated Hindmetal Exploration Services Private Limited (HESPL) as a wholly owned subsidiary. Aligned with the Nation's vision, HESPL is focused on making new mineral discoveries across India and expanding R&R to unlock future growth. In FY 2024-25, HESPL was recognized as a Category-A Exploration Agency by the Government of India under the QCI-NABET Scheme. During the year, it secured the Ballepyllum Tungsten

Block (Andhra Pradesh), Jhandawali-Satipura Potash Block (Rajasthan), and Nawatola-Laband Rare Earth Elements Block (Uttar Pradesh).

With an impressive brownfield exploration success rate of 83.1%, we added 10.89 Mt of ore containing 0.71 Mt of metal at gross level. Deposits remain open laterally and at depth, and with an active exploration program, further increases in R&R are anticipated. Extensive drilling of 472 km (162 km surface and 310.2 km underground) highlights our commitment to precision and efficiency.

Our current R&R supports more than 25 years of metal production at existing mining rates, reflecting our meticulous planning, technological integration, and unwavering commitment to sustainability and growth.





Mines

Driving Safe, Smart & Sustainable Mining Operations

Hindustan Zinc remains committed to sustainable mining, with focused investments to enhance safety, productivity, and efficiency. Its underground mines at Rampura Agucha, Sindesar Khurd, Rajpura Dariba, Zawar, and Kayad in Rajasthan together support an ore production capacity of 18.5 million tonnes per annum with total R&R of 453.2 million tonnes. Guided by Sustainability Goals 2030, the company leverages automation and technology to make mining safer and greener, including deploying India's first Battery Electric Vehicle in underground operations.

Rampura Agucha, the world's largest underground zinc mine, continues to scale to 5.4 Mtpa and hosts the country's richest zinc-lead deposit. Sindesar Khurd, the world's fourth-largest silver mine, has expanded from 0.3 to 5.6 Mtpa and contributes significantly to integrated silver production. Zawar, comprising four ancient yet modernized mines—Mochia, Balaria, Zawarmala, and Baroi—has a combined capacity of 4.75 Mtpa with advanced mechanization and digitization. Rajpura Dariba, among the oldest mines, produces 1.5 Mtpa, while Kayad, the youngest mine launched in 2011, consistently delivers 0.7 Mtpa through high mechanization and digitalization.

Smelters

Melting Ore - Smelting More

Hindustan Zinc is one of the world's largest and India's only integrated Zinc-Lead-Silver producer. Its smelters are located at Chanderiya, Dariba, and Debari in Rajasthan, with a metal refinery at Pantnagar, Uttarakhand. Since disinvestment in 2002, metal production capacity has grown more than five-fold—from 204,000 tonnes per annum to over 1.12 million tonnes.

The Chanderiya Smelting Complex in Chittorgarh is the world's largest single-location integrated zinc smelter, with an annual capacity of 585,000 tonnes of zinc and 90,000 tonnes of lead, supported by captive and green power plants. The Dariba Smelting Complex in Rajsamand produces 240,000 tonnes of zinc and 120,000 tonnes of lead annually and is uniquely self-sufficient, located near Sindesar Khurd and Rajpura Dariba mines. Debari, India's first zinc smelter, has a capacity of 88,000 tonnes of zinc per annum. At Pantnagar, the refinery produces 800 tonnes of silver annually.

Today, Hindustan Zinc's total production capacity stands at 913,000 tonnes of zinc, 210,000 tonnes of lead, and 800 tonnes of silver per annum. With significant capital investments, the company aims to expand overall metal production capacity to 2 million tonnes annually.



Zero Harm, Zero Waste, Zero Discharge

Sustainable development is central to Hindustan Zinc's business philosophy, driving balance across social, environmental, and economic priorities to create long-term value for stakeholders. The company has integrated global best practices and set Sustainability Development Goals 2030 to expand positive change.

Hindustan Zinc operates Udaipur's first 60 MLD Sewage Treatment Plant under the Public-Private Partnership (PPP) model and has implemented Zero Liquid Discharge, rainwater harvesting, paste-fill, and dry tailing plants to strengthen water stewardship. Certified 3.32 times water positive, the company has also developed site-specific Biodiversity Management Plans with International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN).

This year, Hindustan Zinc accelerated its 530 MW renewable energy project, completing the first phase ahead of schedule, and launched EcoZen, Asia's first low-carbon zinc with a carbon footprint nearly 75% below the global average. As the only Indian member of the International Council on Mining and Metals (ICMM), the company aligns with global sustainability standards and ensures credible third-party assured ESG disclosures through frameworks like TNFD, Climate Action Report, GRI-aligned Sustainability Report, and Environmental Product Declaration.

In waste-to-wealth initiatives, the Fumer plant at Chanderiya exemplifies advanced recovery. Hindustan Zinc also pioneers sustainable mobility with three underground BEVs, electric forklifts and tow trucks at smelters, 180 LNG trucks, and 10 EVs in use. Plans are underway to deploy 100 electric trucks with India's first battery-swapping stations and expand the LNG fleet to 200.

Community Development

Hindustan Zinc, a responsible corporate entity, upholds citizen dignity and promotes harmony and inclusive growth. The company has positively impacted 2.3 million lives through initiatives in education, sustainable livelihoods, community asset creation, environment & safety, women empowerment, health, water & sanitation, and sports & culture in FY25.





Enhancing the Government's ICDS program, Hindustan Zinc has modernized Anganwadis into 1,980 Nand Ghars, across Rajasthan. Educational programs like Khushi- Nand Ghar, Shiksha Sambal, Unchi Udaan, Scholarship, and company-run schools benefit over 2 lakh children annually by improving their learning levels.

The Sakhi program empowers over 26,800 rural and tribal women through 2,167 self-help groups (SHGs), providing vocational training and fostering leadership, skill development, savings, and entrepreneurship. The Uthori program, reaching 2.33 lakh beneficiaries, addresses issues like domestic violence and child marriage.

Hindustan Zinc has developed three home grown brands—'Gauam' for dairy, 'Daichi' for food products, and 'Upaya' for textiles—establishing e-commerce and 220+ retail stores, generating ₹2.31 Cr revenue via fast-moving consumer goods (FMCG) and textile sales.





The Samadhan program focuses on sustainable agriculture and livestock interventions, reaching nearly 35,000 farmers benefitted with ₹14.2 Cr in livestock asset creation, producing 82.14 lakh liters of milk worth ₹32.9 Cr.

Zinc Kaushal trains youth across 550 villages in 8 districts, ensuring employability through market-linked programs. It successfully trained the first all-female batch for unarmed security guards and a batch of differently abled youth in hospitality, achieving 100% placement.

Zinc Football, a grassroots football development program, operates a residential academy in Zawar, Udaipur, with top-notch facilities. In association with All India Football Federation (AIFF), the academy has recently launched India's first residential football academy for girls. The AIFF 3 star rated academy has also received the highest accreditation as the 4th best Football Academy in India. Further the academy, has produced national players like Sahil Poonia, Mohammed Kaif and Prem Hansdak.
