
Vedanta chairman bats for Rajasthan's industrial ascent

<u>Vedanta ChairmanAnil Agarwal</u> has urged greater <u>industrial development in Rajasthan</u>, describing the mineral-rich state as India's next potential economic powerhouse. Agarwal also praised Rajasthan's entrepreneurial legacy, saying, "Some of India's greatest entrepreneurs hail from Rajasthan. Their business acumen has made a mark across the globe."

He described the state as having the highest potential for renewable energy, along with significant reserves of oil and gas. "This powerful combination of resources and energy can propel Rajasthan to India's number one state," he added.
