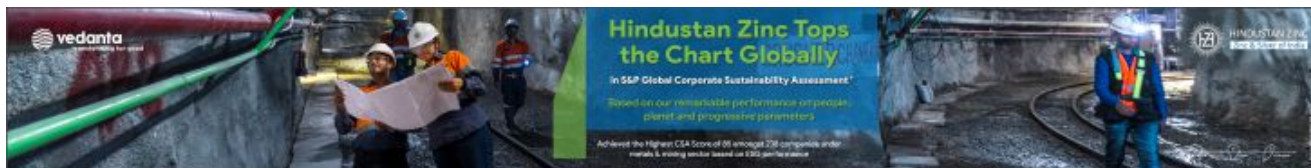


FICCI FLO women delegates visit world's largest Rampura Agucha Mine

60 women representatives of FICCI FLO Jaipur went 850 meters down to Hindustan Zinc's Rampura Agucha Mine and observed the latest technology in the mining sector



60 women representatives of FICCI FLO Jaipur visited the Rampura Agucha Mine, one of the world's largest zinc producing mines of Hindustan Zinc Limited, a Vedanta Group company, and witnessed the latest mining techniques and innovations. During this three-day visit, 20 women every day experienced Hindustan Zinc's Rampura Agucha Mine, 850 meters down in the mine, which is deeper than the height of Burj Khalifa.

The group saw remote-controlled loaders powered by LIDAR technology that can be operated at depths of more than 1,000 metres below the surface, improving both safety and productivity. They also saw IoT-powered systems that can detect and prevent machine breakdowns in advance, and AI-powered safety monitoring systems that enforce strict safety regulations.

A virtual reality simulator for operating a shaft winder was also demonstrated, highlighting Hindustan Zinc's seriousness about providing safe and efficient training. Apart from this, the group of women also witnessed a remote-controlled drilling operation operated from the surface.

The visit perfectly reflects the theme of FICCI FLO Jaipur Chapter for 2025-26 - Heritage, Health and Harmony. The theme aims to combine tradition with new thinking and encourage women to join sectors where women leadership is generally less visible. Important ideas were shared on the development of mining, use of machinery and the growing role of women in industrial sectors. The women learnt in depth how modern mining can be sustainable, bring innovation and strengthen the community.

This experience at Rampura Agucha not only gave them knowledge about mining but also inspired them. It strengthened their belief that women can play an important role even in large industries. This program is part of Hindustan Zinc's ongoing efforts to promote inclusive growth, community participation and learning from experience.
